INVITATION TO BID

Bids for the Town of Centreville Liberty/Commerce Streets Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation, Contract SSR-09-01, will be received from qualified bidders by the Town of Centreville at the Town Hall (address above) until 2:00 p.m. local time on September 23, 2009, at which time they will be opened publicly and read aloud.

The work generally includes the rehabilitation of the Sanitary Sewer Pipe and Manholes on Liberty/Commerce Streets in the Town of Centreville. The work includes the replacement of existing manhole frames and covers, the application of a cementitious liner on the interior of the existing manholes, the installation of clean outs in existing lateral pipes at the edge of ROW and the rehabilitation of existing 8" VCP pipe and lateral piping via the installation of cured in place main line pipe and lateral liners along with the associated restoration of disturbed areas.

Contract documents may be viewed at the Town Hall or at the office of URS, 1200 Philadelphia Pike, Wilmington, Delaware 19809, and may be purchased for a non-refundable fee of fifty (\$50.00) dollars (\$65.00 if shipped). For questions, please contact URS Corporation at 302-791-0700.

A pre-bid meeting (non-mandatory) will be held at 10 AM on September 4, 2009 at the Town Hall Annex (105 North Liberty Street). The Owner reserves the right to waive any informalities and to reject any or all bids. All bids must be accompanied by a bid bond or certified check in the amount of a least 10% of the base bid total for proposal payable to the Town of Centreville.

This project is funded, in part, by the Maryland Water Quality Revolving Loan Fund. Contractors are directed to the requirements reflected in the Supplementary Conditions regarding compliance with construction utilizing these funds and to the following:

1. The terms and conditions of the six (6) affirmative action steps as well as other requirements described in the State Insert entitled "Requirements and Contract Provisions For The Project Financed Through The Maryland Water Quality Revolving Loan Fund And The Maryland Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund."
