CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During calendar year 2011, the department made ninety-five (95) adult arrests, 27 for Assault, 1 for Assault on an Officer, 2 for Bad Checks, 1 for Breaking and Entering, 9 for CDS, 1 for Driving with a Revoked License, 10 for Driving with a Suspended License, 1 for Driving Uninsured, 2 for Driving with out a License, 2 for DUI, 2 for DWI, 1 for Escape 2nd Degree, 7 for Fail to Appear, 2 for Fail to Send Child to School, 1 for Harassment, 3 for Malicious Destruction of Property, 1 for Non Support of a Minor, 1 for Possession of Alcohol Under 21, 1 for Prurient Intent, 1 for Rogue and Vagabond, 2 for Telephone Misuse, 9 for Theft, 2 for Trespassing, 1 for Unauthorized Use of Vehicle, and 5 for Violation of Probation.

The department made twenty-nine (29) juvenile arrests, 3 for Assault, 1 for Burglary, 4 for CDS, 5 for Disrupting School, 1 for DUI, 1 for Failure to Obey a Police Officer, 1 for Leaving School, 3 for MDOP, 4 for Possession of Alcohol, 2 for Runaway, 3 for Theft and 1 for Truancy.

The department served 34 Emergency Petitions and investigated 419 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During calendar year 2011, the department issued 88 Speeding Citations, 45 Suspended / Revoked Citations, 17 DWI/DUI Citations, 281 other traffic citations, including 47 traffic arrests, 1316 motor vehicle warnings and 322 equipment repair orders for a total of 2069 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The department issued 309 expired meter violation citations, 108 restricted parking citations, 36 incorrect parking citations and 13 other parking citations for a total of 466 parking violations. The department responded to 105 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During calendar year 2011, the department responded to 4836 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the year was 5354.
