CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of April 2012, the department made twelve (12) adult arrests, 1 for Assault, 2 for Theft, 4 for Driving Suspended, 1 for Driving Without a License, 1 for Disorderly Conduct, 1 for Failure to Appear, 1 for Violation of Probation, and 1 for Trespassing. The department made no juvenile arrests. The department served no Emergency Petitions and investigated 28 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of April 2012, the department issued 25 traffic citations, including 6 traffic arrests, 61 motor vehicle warnings and 15 equipment repair orders for a total of 104 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The department issued 28 expired meter violation citations, 4 restricted parking citations and 1 incorrect parking citation and 1 handicap violation parking citation for a total of 34 parking violations. The department responded to 8 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of April 2012, the department responded to 408 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of April was 444.
