CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of December 2012, the department made Ten (10) adult arrests; 6 for Driving on Suspended License, 1 for FTA Warrant, 1 for Violation of Probation Warrant, 1 for Forgery and 1 for 4th Degree Sex offense. The Department did not make any juvenile arrests. The Department investigated 25 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of December 2012, the Department issued 27 traffic citations, 95 motor vehicle warnings and 13 equipment repair orders for a total of 135 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The Department issued 7 expired meter violation citations and 10 incorrect parking citations for a total of 17 parking violations. The Department also responded to 7 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of December 2012, the Department responded to 384 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of December was 416.
