CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of June 2012, the department made Ten (10) adult arrests, 4 for 2nd Degree Assault, 2 for Failure to Appear, 2 for CDS, 1 for Violation of Probation and 1 for a Fugitive Warrant. The Department made no juvenile arrests. The Department investigated 32 Part I and II crimes and also served 2 Emergency Petitions.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of June 2012, the Department made Six (6) traffic arrests, 4 for driving while suspended, 1 for driving while revoked, and 1 for car rental agreement violation. The Department issued 73 traffic citations, 181 motor vehicle warnings and 24 equipment repair orders for a total of 278 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The Department issued 15 expired meter violation citations, 2 restricted parking citations and 1 incorrect parking citation, for a total of 18 parking violations. The Department also responded to 11 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of June 2012, the Department responded to 79 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of June was 419.
