CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of March 2012, the department made sixteen (16) adult arrests, 4 for CDS, 3 for Theft, 2 for Driving Suspended, 2 for Failure to Appear in Court, 1 for 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Assault, 1 for Disorderly Conduct, 1 for Bad Check, 1 for Violation of Probation and 1 for Driving Uninsured. The department made four (4) juvenile arrests, 1 for Burglary, 1 for CDS, 1 for Theft and 1 for 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Assault. The department served 1 Emergency Petition and investigated 35 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of March 2012, the department issued 26 traffic citations, including 3 traffic arrests, 108 motor vehicle warnings and 18 equipment repair orders for a total of 155 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The department issued 48 expired meter violation citations, 4 restricted parking citations and 18 incorrect parking citations for a total of 66 parking violations. The department responded to 4 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of March 2012, the department responded to 486 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of March was 525.
