CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of November 2012, the department made Seven (7) adult arrests; 4 for Possession of CDS, 1 for Driving while revoked and 2 for VOP Warrants. The Department also made Five (5) juvenile arrests; 3 for 2nd Degree Assault, 1 for CDS and 1 for being disruptive in school and paraphernalia. The Department investigated 24 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of November 2012, the Department issued 18 traffic citations, 50 motor vehicle warnings and 21 equipment repair orders for a total of 89 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The Department issued 2 expired meter violation citations and 10 incorrect parking citations for a total of 12 parking violations. The Department also responded to 7 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of November 2012, the Department responded to 252 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of November was 283.
