CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of September 2012, the department made Four (4) adult arrests; 3 for 2nd degree assault and 1 criminal summons for Theft less than \$1,000, the Department made no juvenile arrests. The Department investigated 42 Part I and II crimes and also served 4 Emergency Petitions.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of September 2012, the Department issued 13 traffic citations, 60 motor vehicle warnings and 15 equipment repair orders for a total of 88 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The Department issued 37 expired meter violation citations and 4 other citations, for a total of 41 parking violations. The Department also responded to 7 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of September 2012, the Department responded to 233 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of September was 282.
