CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During calendar year 2012, the Department made One Hundred Four (104) adult arrests, 11 for Assault, 3 for Bad Checks, 1 for Breaking and Entering, 17 for Controlled Dangerous Substance Violations, 4 for Disorderly Conduct, 1 for Forgery, 5 for Failure to Appear, 1 for Reckless Endangerment, 1 for 4th Degree Sex Offense, 9 for Theft, 1 for Trespassing, 5 for Violation of Probation, 2 for Driving with a Revoked License, 23 for Driving with a Suspended License, 4 for Driving Uninsured, 1 for Driving without a License, 1 for Driving While Intoxicated, 1 for a Rental Car Agreement Violation, 7 for Criminal Summons Service, and 6 for Warrant Service.

The Department made Eleven (11) juvenile arrests, 4 for Assault, 1 for Burglary, 2 for Controlled Dangerous Substance Violations, 2 for Theft and 2 for Disrupting School.

The Department served 17 Emergency Petitions and investigated 339 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During calendar year 2012, the Department issued 367 Traffic Citations including 32 Traffic Arrests, 985 motor vehicle warnings and 219 equipment repair orders for a total of 1,571 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The Department issued 263 expired meter violation citations, 48 restricted parking citations, 69 incorrect parking citations and 10 other parking citations for a total of 390 parking violations. The Department responded to 90 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During calendar year 2012, the Department responded to 3,772 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the year was 4,201.
