CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of April 2013, Officers made Fourteen (14) adult arrests 1 for Disorderly Conduct and Disruption of School Activities; 2 for Failure to send child to school and Contribute to the delinquency of a minor; 2 for Driving revoked; 1 for DUI and fleeing & eluding; 1 for Driving while suspended; 1 for Driving without a license, 1 for Theft less than \$100; 2 for Failure to appear; 1 for Theft less than \$1,000 and Theft of a credit card; 1 for 1st Degree assault, 2nd Degree assault and Reckless endangerment; 1 for 2nd Degree Assault. There were no juvenile arrests this month.

The Department investigated 24 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of April 2013, Officers issued 64 traffic citations including 2 for Driving on Suspended and/or Revoked License and 1 for Driving under the Influence. Officers also issued 193 motor vehicle warnings and 19 equipment repair orders for a total of 279 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. Officers issued 14 incorrect parking citations and 31 expired meter citations for a total of 45 parking violations. Officers also responded to 13 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of April 2013, Officers responded to 468 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of April was 505.
