CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of August 2013, Officers made Ten (10) adult arrests including 2 for Controlled Dangerous Substance Violations, 1 for Malicious Destruction of Property and attempted Breaking & Entering, 3 for Warrant Service and 4 for Criminal Summons Service. Officers did not make any juvenile arrests.

The Department investigated 50 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of August 2013, Officers issued 46 traffic citations including 5 traffic arrests, 3 driving on suspended license, 1 for driving without a license and 1 for driving uninsured motor vehicle. Officers also issued 140 motor vehicle warnings and 30 equipment repair orders for a total of 219 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. Officers issued 34 expired meter citations and 15 restricted parking citations for a total of 49 parking violations. Officers also responded to 16 motor vehicle accidents.

During the month of August, the Redspeed Automated Speed Enforcement (ASE) Camera issued 56 Traffic Citations.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of August 2013, Officers responded to 342 miscellaneous incidents including service of 5 Emergency Petitions. The total of all service calls for the month of August was 408.
