CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of December 2013, Officers made Two (2) adult arrests:

- 2 for Theft

Officers did not make any juvenile arrests.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of December 2013, Officers issued 37 traffic citations, including the following arrestable offenses:

- 2 for Driving on Suspended/Revoked License

Officers also issued:

- 75 motor vehicle warnings
- 20 Safety Equipment Repair Orders
- 6 parking citations

Officers also responded to 5 motor vehicle collisions.
