CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of February 2013, the Department made Seven (7) adult arrests 3 for Driving with Suspended license, 1 for Driving while Revoked and Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance, 1 for Driving without a License, 1 Warrant for Failure to Appear in Court and 1 Warrant for Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance not Marihuana. The Department also made One (1) juvenile arrest for Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance. The Department investigated 27 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of February 2013, the Department issued 52 traffic citations including 5 traffic arrests, 79 motor vehicle warnings, 32 equipment repair orders for a total of 163 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The Department issued 28 expired meter violation citations, 13 restricted parking citations and 14 incorrect parking citations for a total of 55 parking violations. The Department also responded to 4 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of February 2013, the Department responded to 340 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of February was 371.
