CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of January 2013, the department made Sixteen (16) adult arrests; 6 Traffic arrests (2 Driving Under the Influence, 2 Driving on suspended license, 1 possessing a suspended license and 1 driving while revoked and CDS), 5 for Warrant Service (1 Violation of Probation, 1 for Theft, 1 for Failure to Appear and 2 for Fraud/ID Theft), 4 for Criminal Summon Service (2 for Theft Less Than \$100, 1 for Controlled Dangerous Substance and 1 for Malicious Destruction of Property) and 1 for Theft, Controlled Dangerous Substance and Carrying a concealed dangerous weapon. The Department did not make any juvenile arrests. The Department investigated 35 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of January 2013, the Department issued 39 traffic citations, 84 motor vehicle warnings, 29 equipment repair orders for a total of 152 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The Department issued 16 expired meter violation citations, 14 restricted parking citations and 9 other violations for a total of 39 parking violations. The Department also responded to 10 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of January 2013, the Department responded to 396 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of January was 441.
