CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of May 2013, Officers made Twelve (12) adult arrests 3 for Criminal Summons Service, 1 for Controlled Dangerous Substance Possession, 3 for Driving on Suspended License, 1 for Assault and 4 for Warrant Service. Officers also made One (1) juvenile arrest for Disruption of School.

The Department investigated 52 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of May 2013, Officers issued 49 traffic citations including 3 traffic arrests for Driving on Suspended License. Officers also issued 133 motor vehicle warnings, 29 equipment repair orders for a total of 211 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. Officers issued 41 expired meter citations and 6 incorrect parking citations for a total of 47 parking violations. Officers responded to 10 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of May 2013, Officers responded to 439 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of May was 501.
