CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of November 2013, Officers made Six (6) adult arrests:

- 1 for Disorderly Conduct/Failing to obey lawful order
- 1 for Shoplifting
- 1 for Domestic Assault
- 2 for Strong Armed Robbery
- 1 for 2nd Degree Burglary

Officers did not make any juvenile arrests.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of November 2013, Officers issued 46 traffic citations, including the following arrestable offenses:

- 3 for Driving on Suspended/Revoked License
- 1 for Driving Uninsured Motor Vehicle

Officers also issued:
-92 motor vehicle warnings
-27 Safety Equipment Repair Orders
-7 restricted parking citations

Officers also responded to 9 motor vehicle collisions.

The Redspeed Automated Speed Enforcement (ASE) Camera located on Kidwell Ave. issued 617 Traffic Citations.

COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of November 2013, Officers responded to a total of 352 incidents, including 2 armed robberies.

SPECIAL ASSIGNMENTS
