### CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of October 2013, Officers made Four (4) adult arrests:

- 1 for Disorderly Conduct/Failing to obey lawful order
- 3 for Warrant Service

Officers did not make any juvenile arrests.

### TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of October 2013, Officers issued 63 traffic citations, including the following arrestable offenses:

- 8 for Driving on Suspended/Revoked License
- 1 for Possessing a Suspended License

Officers also issued:

- 111 motor vehicle warnings
- 40 Safety Equipment Repair Orders
- 25 expired meter citations
- 10 restricted parking citations

Officers also responded to 11 motor vehicle collisions.

The Redspeed Automated Speed Enforcement (ASE) Camera located on Kidwell Ave. issued 363 Traffic Citations.

### COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of October 2013, Officers responded to a total of 394 incidents including service of 1 Emergency Petition.
