CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of September 2013, Officers made Ten (10) adult arrests:

- 2 for Controlled Dangerous Substance
- 1 for Malicious Destruction of Property and attempted Breaking & Entering,
- 3 for Warrant Service
- 4 for Criminal Summons Service.

Officers did not make any juvenile arrests.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of September 2013, Officers issued 29 traffic citations, including the following arrestable offenses:

- 3 for Driving on Suspended/Revoked License
- 1 for Driving without a license
- 1 for Driving uninsured vehicle

Officers also issued:

- 119 motor vehicle warnings
- 23 Safety Equipment Repair Orders
- 7 expired meter citations
- 1 restricted parking citation

Officers also responded to 9 motor vehicle collisions.
