CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of August 2014, Officers made Seven (7) adult arrests:

- 1 On-view for Disorderly Conduct/Resisting Arrest
- 1 for Warrant Service for FTA
- 5 for Criminal Summons Service for Theft, 2nd Degree Assault, Fleeing & Eluding

Officers made One (1) juvenile arrests for CDS.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of August 2014, Officers issued:

- 26 traffic citations
- 155 motor vehicle warnings
- 41 Safety Equipment Repair Orders
- 27 parking citations

Officers also responded to 2 motor vehicle collisions.
