CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of December 2014, Officers made a total of 5 criminal arrests

Four (4) adult arrests:

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of December 2014, Officers issued the following:
