CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of July 2014, Officers made Three (3) adult arrests:

- 1 On-view for Credit Card Fraud
- 1 for Warrant Service for Theft
- 1 for Criminal Summons Service for 2nd Degree Assault

Officers did not make any juvenile arrests.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of July 2014, Officers issued 28 traffic citations, including the following arrestable offenses:
