CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of June 2014, Officers made Eight (8) adult arrests:

- 1 On-view for 2nd Degree Assault
- 5 for Warrant Service:
 - 2 for Failure To Appear
 - 2 for 2nd Degree Assault
 - 1 for Violation of Probation
- 2 for Criminal Summons Service:
 - 2 for 2nd Degree Assault

Officers made 1 juvenile arrest for 2nd Degree Assault.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of June 2014, Officers issued 86 traffic citations, including the following arrestable offenses:

- 8 for Driving while suspended/revoked
- 2 for Driving w/o license
- 1 for other arrestable traffic offense

Officers also issued:

- 213 motor vehicle warnings
- 73 Safety Equipment Repair Orders
- 12 parking citations

Officers also responded to 12 motor vehicle collisions.

The Redspeed Automated Speed Enforcement Camera located on Railroad Ave. issued 103 Traffic Citations.
