CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of September 2014, Officers made a TOTAL of 10 CRIMINAL ARRESTS:

Nine (9) adult arrests:

- 2 On-view : 1 for Assault and 1 for Theft
- 6 for Warrant Service:
 - 2 for Assault
 - 1 for Violation of Probation
 - 1 for Burglary
 - 1 for Theft
 - 1 for FTA
- 1 for Criminal Summons Service for Theft

One (1) juvenile arrest:

- 1 for CDS

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of September 2014, Officers issued:

- 92 traffic citations
- 257 motor vehicle warnings
- 98 Safety Equipment Repair Orders
- 19 parking citations

The Redspeed Automated Speed Enforcement Cameras located on Railroad Ave. and Chesterfield Ave. issued a combined 235 Traffic Citations.
