CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of April 2015, Officers made a TOTAL of 4 CRIMINAL ARRESTS:
Four (4) Adult Arrests:

- 2 for Warrant Service:
 - 2 for Failure to Appear

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of April 2015, Officers issued the following:

- 25 Arrestable Citations:
 - 8 for Driving on a Suspended/Revoked License
 - 5 for Driving Without a License
 - 12 other arrest able citations
- 100 non-arrest able Traffic Citations

- 92 Safety Equipment Repair Orders
- 54 Parking Citations
