### CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of December 2015, Officers made a TOTAL of 7 CRIMINAL ARRESTS:

*Six (6) Adult Arrests:*

### TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY
