### CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of February 2015, Officers made a TOTAL of 5 CRIMINAL ARRESTS:  
Five (5) Adult Arrests:

- 3 for Warrant Service:
  - 2 for Violation of Probation
  - 1 for Failure to Appear
- 1 for Criminal Summons Service for Malicious Destruction of Property

### TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of February 2015, Officers issued the following:
