CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of July 2015, Officers made a TOTAL of 4 CRIMINAL ARRESTS:
Four (4) Adult Arrests:

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of July 2015, Officers issued the following:

- 2 Arrestable Citations:

- 52 non-arrestable Traffic Citations
- 519 Motor Vehicle Warnings
- 63 Safety Equipment Repair Orders
