CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of June 2015, Officers made a TOTAL of 8 CRIMINAL ARRESTS:

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of June 2015, Officers issued the following:
