### CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of November 2015, Officers made a TOTAL of 7 CRIMINAL ARRESTS:

*Five (5) Adult Arrests:*

- 4 for Warrant Service:
  - 2 for Theft
  - 1 for 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Assault
  - 1 for Armed Robbery
- 1 for Criminal Summons Service:
  - 1 for Theft

*Two (2) Juvenile Arrests:*

- 1 for Disrupting School
- 1 for Runaway

### TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of November 2015, Officers issued the following:

- 11 Arrestable Citations, including:
  - 10 for Driving on a Suspended/Revoked License
  - 1 for other arrestable offense
- 19 non-arrestable Traffic Citations
- 250 Motor Vehicle Warnings
- 28 Safety Equipment Repair Orders
- 27 Parking Citations

The Redspeed Automated Speed Enforcement Cameras located on Railroad Avenue and Chesterfield Avenue issued a combined 32 Traffic Citations.
