CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of August 2016, Officers made a TOTAL of 5 CRIMINAL ARRESTS:
Five (5) Adult Arrests:

1 for Violation of Probation

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY
