CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of July 2016, Officers made a TOTAL of 7 CRIMINAL ARRESTS:

Five (5) Adult Arrests:

- 3 on-view for: 1 Disturbing the Peace & Assault on Police Officer
1 Theft less than \$100
1 Domestic Assault
- 1 Warrant Service for Fail To Appear
- 1 Criminal Summons Service for Driving Suspended

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of July 2016, Officers issued the following:
