CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of September 2016, Officers made a TOTAL of 2 CRIMINAL ARRESTS:

Two (2) Adult Arrests:

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of September 2016, Officers issued the following:

- 15 Arrestable Traffic Citations, including:
 - 12 for Driving on a Suspended/Revoked License
 - 3 for Driving w/o License
- 32 non-arrestable Traffic Citations
- 223 Motor Vehicle Warnings
- 12 Safety Equipment Repair Orders
- 10 Parking Citations

The Redspeed Automated Speed Enforcement Cameras located on Railroad Avenue and Chesterfield Avenue issued a combined 107 Traffic Citations.
