DID YOU KNOW there is a new Stormwater Education Station at Mill Stream Park in Centreville?

The Stormwater Education Station is a faux house with examples of stormwater management technologies:

- ✚ Green Roof
- ✚ Rain Barrels directed to a Rain Garden
- ✚ Rain Garden with Native Plants
- ✚ Permeable Pavers
- ✚ Educational Signage about the Stormwater Features

The educational signage informs residents about what they can do prevent stormwater pollution and clean up local waterways.

The Stormwater Education Station was installed by Centreville Community volunteers, businesses, students at Centreville Middle School, and Ruthsburg Boys Scout Troop.
