CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of July 2011, the department made fourteen (14) adult arrests, 1 for Theft, 3 for Assault, 2 for CDS, 1 for Driving on a Revoked License, 5 for Driving on a Suspended License, 1 for Possession of Alcohol Under 21 and 1 for Harassment. The department made two (2) juvenile arrests, 1 for Failure to Obey a Police Officer and 1 for Possession of Alcohol Under 21. The department investigated 28 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of July 2011, the department issued 37 traffic citations, including 10 traffic arrest, 114 motor vehicle warnings and 31 equipment repair orders for a total of 188 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The department issued 7 expired meter violation citations, 1 restricted parking citation, 12 incorrect parking citations and 1 exceeding 15 minute parking limit for a total of 22 parking violations. The department responded to 9 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of July 2011, the department responded to 408 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of July was 445.

SPECIAL ASSIGNMENTS

- 07/01/11 Personnel initiated the new parking meter rates and parking fine schedule.
- 07/02/11 Personnel provided traffic and crowd control during the "Centreville Day" events, including the Wharf dedication, the Taste of Centreville and the fireworks demonstration.
- 07/15/11 Personnel provided traffic and crowd control at the "Centreville Alive" block party.
- 07/31/11 Chief Rhodes provided a police escort for the "Chrome City Motorcycle Ride" to the Benedictine School which raised approximately \$106,000.
