CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of October 2011, the department made eight (8) adult arrests, 2 for Assault, 2 for CDS, 2 for Driving on a Suspended License, 1 for Trespassing and 1 for Prurient Intent. The department made one (1) juvenile arrest for Theft. The department had 3 Emergency Petitions and investigated 45 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of October 2011, the department issued 21 traffic citations, including 4 traffic arrests, 92 motor vehicle warnings and 22 equipment repair orders for a total of 135 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The department issued 26 expired meter violation citations, 1 restricted parking citation and 7 incorrect parking citations for a total of 34 parking violations. The department responded to 8 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of October 2011, the department responded to 372 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of October was 425.
