CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of February 2011, the department made six (6) adult arrests, 1 for Assault, 1 for Driving under the Influence, 2 for Theft and 1 for Violation of Probation. The department made two (2) juvenile arrests for Disrupting School / Disorderly Conduct. The department investigated 25 Part I and II crimes and 451 other miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of February was 481.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of February 2011, the department issued 3 ordinance violation citations, 38 traffic citations, including 1 traffic arrest, 131 motor vehicle warnings and 36 equipment repair orders for a total of 208 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The department issued 63 meter violations citations, 5 restricted parking citations, 4 incorrect parking citations and 12 other parking violations for a total of 84 parking violations. The department responded to 5 motor vehicle accidents.
