CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of March 2011, the department made four (4) adult arrests, 1 for Assault, 1 for Breaking and Entering, and 2 for Failure to Appear. The department made four (4) juvenile arrests, 2 for Disrupting School, 1 for Assault and 1 for Runaway. The department investigated 35 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of March 2011, the department issued 28 traffic citations, including 2 traffic arrests, 164 motor vehicle warnings and 31 equipment repair orders for a total of 225 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The department issued 90 meter violations citations, 1 restricted parking citation, 7 incorrect parking citations for a total of 98 parking violations. The department responded to 8 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of March 2011, the department responded to 415 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of March was 458.
