CRIMINAL ACTIVITY

During the month of April 2011, the department made eight (8) adult arrests, 2 for Bad Checks, 1 for Violation of Probation, 2 for Failure to Send Child to School, 1 for CDS, 1 for MDOP and 1 for Failure to Appear. The department made three (3) juvenile arrests, 2 for CDS and 1 for Truancy. The department investigated 39 Part I and II crimes.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of April 2011, the department issued 37 traffic citations, including 7 traffic arrests, 130 motor vehicle warnings and 23 equipment repair orders for a total of 190 citations, warnings, and equipment repair orders. The department issued 29 expired meter violation citations, 6 restricted parking citation, 5 incorrect parking citations and 1 handicap zone violation citation for a total of 41 parking violations. The department responded to 10 motor vehicle accidents.

MISCELLANEOUS COMPLAINTS / INCIDENTS

During the month of April 2011, the department responded to 476 miscellaneous incidents. The total of all service calls for the month of April was 525.
