Hydrant Flushing: Front Street & Watson Road October 18th

The Town of Centreville will be flushing hydrants tomorrow, October 18th beginning at approximately 10:00 a.m. on Front Street and Watson Road. We ask that you do not attempt to do laundry during the flushing, as the water may become discolored and cause staining. If discolored water is noticed, turn your cold water on and let it run for a few minutes after flushing until the water is clear.

Customers may also experience temporary decreases in water pressure during hydrant flushing activities. Water pressure will quickly return to normal levels at the completion of the flushing.

Updated Utility Bill On-Line Payment System

The Town of Centreville recently updated the utility bill on-line payment system. Residents will now be required to enter a Utility Account ID number as well as a Utility Account PIN. Both numbers are located on your utility bill. These are new privacy features for the benefit of our citizens. The link can

be found on the Town's website at www.townofcentreville.org and is located in the top right hand corner of the home page.

Also, this updated on-line system allows partial payments to be made whereas the old system only allowed full payments. As long as the full amount of your utility bill is paid by the due date, no late fees will be applied.

Centreville Christmas Parade Applications Now Being Accepted

The 2017 Centreville Christmas Parade is scheduled for Friday, December 1st beginning at 6:30 p.m. This year's theme will be ***A Chesapeake Bay Christmas (land and bay)***. A maximum of 90 entries will once again be permitted this year.

It is the intent of the parade committee to make this parade float oriented and trophies will be awarded to floats only. Although walking groups are permitted to participate, to help with the supervision and safety of the parade, the committee is encouraging **no** walking groups (except marching bands). Please indicate the total length of your entry (float & vehicle), truck, bus, engine, etc. in order to space the line-up accordingly at the Queen Anne's County High School.

The parade route is scheduled to leave Queen Anne's County High School at 6:30 p.m., proceed down Ruthsburg Road/Railroad Avenue and take a right onto Banjo Lane and turn left onto Turpins Lane, continue on Turpins Lane and turn left onto Commerce Street; continue on Commerce Street and turn left on Kidwell Avenue; continue on Kidwell Avenue and turn right on Ruthsburg Road. The parade will continue on Ruthsburg Road and return and disband at the Queen Anne's County High School.
