## **CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY**

During the month of December 2016, Officers made a TOTAL of 8 CRIMINAL ARRESTS:

4 Adult Arrests:

- 2 warrant services: 1 for Violation of Probation  
1 for Failure to Appear
- 2 on-view: 1 for 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Domestic Assault  
1 for CDS Possession w/ Intent to Distribute in School Zone

4 Juvenile Arrests:

- 1 for Disrupting School and Poss. Of CDS Paraphernalia
- 3 for Poss. Of CDS w/ Intent to Distribute in School Zone

## **TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY**

During the month of December 2016, Officers issued the following:
