CRIMINAL ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY

During the month of October 2016, Officers made a TOTAL of 5 CRIMINAL ARRESTS:

Four (4) Adult Arrests:

- 4 warrant services: 1 for Armed Robbery
1 for Violation of Probation
1 for 2nd Degree Assault
1 for Driving on Suspended Lic.

One juvenile arrest for disrupting school.

TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT ACTIVITY
