

**TOWN COUNCIL OF CENTREVILLE
ORDINANCE NUMBER 10-2021**

AN ORDINANCE for the purpose of providing for election terms not otherwise provided for in the Charter for the Town of Centreville and all matters related thereto.

WHEREAS, Robert R. Hardy, Jr. has submitted a letter of resignation to the Town Council, such resignation to be effective July 6, 2021;

WHEREAS, since the remaining term for Council Member Hardy is longer than 180 days, Section 414 of the Charter of the Town of Centreville provides that the vacancy shall be filled at the next regular election;

WHEREAS, the Town Council of Centreville has a regular election scheduled for October 4, 2021;

WHEREAS, Council Member Hardy's remaining term on the date of the election will be two years;

WHEREAS, the Charter does not contemplate two seats for varying terms for the October 4, 2021 election;

WHEREAS, Section 416 of the Charter of the Town of Centreville authorizes the Town Council to provide by ordinance for terms of an election that are not otherwise covered by provisions of the Charter; and

WHEREAS, the Town Council wishes to provide that the candidate receiving the second highest number of votes will be elected to a two-year term (and the candidate receiving the highest number of votes will be elected to a three-year term).

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby Ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Centreville that:

Section 1. The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein by reference and made a part of this Ordinance.


Section 2. The vacancy created by the resignation of Council Member Hardy shall be filled at the October 4, 2021 general election of the Town.

Section 3. The candidate receiving the second highest number of votes shall be elected to a two-year term.


Section 4. This Ordinance shall become effective twenty days after its enactment.


