TOWN COUNCIL OF CENTREVILLE ORDINANCE NO. 02-2017

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF CENTREVILLE TO REPEAL AND REENACT A NEW OFFICIAL CRITICAL AREA MAP FOR THE TOWN OF CENTREVILLE

WHEREAS, the Town of Centreville ("Town") is authorized by the Maryland Annotated Code ("Code"), Land Use Article, Section 4-204 to amend, repeal, and modify all zoning maps contained therein; and,

WHEREAS, the State of Maryland enacted House Bill 1253, requiring the Department of Natural Resources and Critical Area Commission to prepare a Statewide Base Map updating the 1,000 foot Critical Area boundary adding the local Critical Area designations; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the regulations of COMAR 27.01.11.06, the Town of Centreville is required to adopt the updated Critical Area map; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, Critical Area Commission, and Town staff have reviewed the required amendments to the current Critical Area map; and

WHEREAS, the Town has prepared an updated Critical Area map which reflects the Statewide Base Map critical area boundaries and designations of the Town of Centreville of all lands within the Town's boundaries.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF CENTREVILLE AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1: The Town Code of the Town of Centreville §170-3 is hereby amended by repealing the Critical Area Map of the Town of Centreville and adopting the Critical Area Map attached hereto, bearing the date ______, as the Official Critical Area Map of the Town of Centreville.
- Section 2: This Ordinance shall become effective on the later of (1) the date of Critical Area Commission approval; or (2) the twenty first (21^{s1}) day after adoption.


