Bridge Replacement Planned; Public Meeting Scheduled

The Maryland Department of Transportation State Highway Administration (MDOT SHA) will replace the bridge on MD 213 (Centreville Road) over Old Mill Stream Branch in Centreville, Queen Anne's County. The project is currently in the design phase and is on schedule to begin construction in Fall 2018.

For additional information, you are invited to attend a public meeting scheduled for Thursday, April 26, 2018. The informational meeting will familiarize attendees with the project and provide an opportunity to discuss project details. Maps and displays will provide project information, and MDOT SHA representatives will be available to answer project-related questions. **There will be no formal presentation. You may arrive at any time during meeting hours and walk through at your own pace.** (See back of newsletter for meeting details.)

Questions and Answers

Why is the work necessary?

The two-lane bridge carrying MD 213 over Old Mill Stream Branch was originally constructed in 1912 and rehabilitated and widened in 1945. While the bridge is structurally safe for travel, it is in poor condition and nearing the end of its useful life, requiring the bridge to be replaced. Replacing the bridge will support the safety and mobility of motorists and reduce maintenance costs. This project is part of MDOT SHA's bridge system preservation program, which provides reliable bridges in a timely manner.

When will work be completed?

Construction is scheduled to begin in Fall 2018. MDOT SHA will make every effort to complete this project as quickly as possible while minimizing impacts on local residents, businesses, and motorists. Based on the significant utility relocations, scope of the work, and experience on similar projects, it is anticipated the project will take approximately one year to complete, weather permitting.

How will traffic be impacted during construction?

MDOT SHA is considering various maintenance of traffic alternatives that will minimize the amount of time roads are closed during construction. Traffic management alternatives and/or detour information will be available at the public meeting.
