

**TOWN COUNCIL OF CENTREVILLE
AMENDED RESOLUTION 09-2016**

AN AMENDED RESOLUTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING CERTAIN RATES, FEES AND CHARGES TO BE PAID TO THE TOWN OF CENTREVILLE PURSUANT TO THE AUTHORITY SET FORTH IN THE TOWN OF CENTREVILLE ZONING CODE, SECTION 12 AND ALL MATTERS RELATING TO SAID RATES, FEES AND CHARGES.

WHEREAS, previous to the adoption of this Resolution, Ordinance 620 has set forth certain rates, fees and charges to be paid to the Town of Centreville; and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 0-04-01, the Town Council of Centreville repealed Ordinance 620 and determined that rates, fees, and charges would be established, altered and amended from time to time by Resolution; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution is intended by the Town Council of Centreville to amend the current fee schedule as determined by Resolution 0-03-01; and

WHEREAS, the Town Charter gives the Town Council of Centreville the power to regulate and control the levying of fees and charges to cover services provided to the residents of Centreville.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Council of Centreville that the following list of rates, fees and charges shall be charged for solar arrays until changed by the Town Council of Centreville.

101-350 arrays	\$1,000.00	200-400 amps	\$100.00
351-600 arrays	\$1,500.00	400-1,000 amps	\$170.00
601 and up	\$2,500.00	Over 1,000 amps	\$220.00
