### ***Yard Waste to Begin Monday, March 18th***

### ***Centreville MD 213 Bridge Replacements***

#### **A message from the Maryland State Highway Administration:**

The first weekend closure of MD 213 at Gravel Run on the north end of Centreville is set for the weekend of March 29, weather permitting. SHA will close MD 213 at the bridge (in front of Hardee's and Subway) at 7:00 p.m. Friday night, March 29. This closure will remain in place through the weekend. MD 213 will reopen to traffic by 5:00 a.m. Monday morning, April 1. Detour signs will be posted. The closure is necessary to assemble and place the temporary "jump bridge" that will keep traffic moving while crews repair the bridge substructure and replace the bridge deck this spring. This is the first of up to four weekend closures needed at the Gravel Run location.

At the south end of town, preliminary work to replace the MD 213 bridge over Old Mill Stream Branch continues. The staging/construction area has been established and crews began driving "sheet piles" along the stream. This work will continue through March. Some of the piles will be driven in the travel lanes of MD 213 - this will require a single lane flagging operation at night. The sheet piles are joined to form a continuous wall to support the stream bank in the bridge area. To minimize traffic impacts the new bridge will actually be constructed in the staging area. Using weekend closures crews will remove the old bridge and slide the new bridge into place on rails later this year. This bridge replacement also will require up to four weekend closures.

Frequent wildlife in both areas include both blue and green herons, bald eagles and osprey, king fishers, swallows, terns, rock doves, mallards, Canada geese, lesser yellow legs and red wing blackbirds. The stream is also home to beaver, muskrats and many species of fish. The area also has historical significance as a busy shipping and trade waterway. The observation walk off of Corsica Street offers a wonderful view of the Corsica Captain's Houses.

The Centreville Park Advisory Board meets the first Tuesday of each month. Residents of Centreville are encouraged to participate and are welcome to bring fresh ideas or concerns.
