**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF CENTREVILLE, MARYLAND  
DELEGATING RESPONSIBILITY TO THE CENTREVILLE BOARD OF  
SUPERVISORS OF ELECTIONS TO VERIFY INDIVIDUALS THAT SIGNED A  
PETITION ARE QUALIFIED VOTERS**

**WHEREAS**, on June 20, 2019 the Town Council of Centreville received a petition for referendum to amend Section 201 of the Town Charter to increase the Town Council from three members to five members; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 4-305 (b) (1) of the Local Government Article states that the legislative body shall verify that each individual who signed the petition is a qualified voter for the municipal general election; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Council of Centreville wishes to delegate responsibility to verify individuals that signed the petition for referendum are qualified voters.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Town Council of Centreville, Maryland authorizing the Centreville Board of Supervisors of Elections to verify individuals that signed the petition for referendum submitted on June 20, 2019 to amend Section 201 of the Town Charter are qualified voters by August 7, 2019.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that individuals will be verified from a voter registration list obtained from the Queen Anne's County Board of Elections with a cut-off date of June 4, 2019; the same list used during the petition process to ensure the number of registered voters are the same as when the number of signatures needed was determined.

**READ AND PASSED THIS** 11th **DAY OF** July, **2019.**


