Town of Centreville Buildings

Closed to Public Access

The Town Council of Centreville, at its March 12th meeting, approved the Town government to follow policies set forth by Queen Anne's County in relation to COVID-19.

At this time, all Town government buildings (Town Hall, Finance Office, Public Works, and Police Department) will be restricted to employees only and no public access will be permitted until further notice.

Employees will still be available via phone and email to correspond with the public. Please remember that payments for water and sewer bills can be made on-line [via this link](#) and parking tickets can also be paid on-line [via this link](#). If payment needs to be made by cash, please contact Town Hall (410-758-1180) and place it in an envelope and use the door slot located in the front door of Town Hall (left-hand side).

Permits may be submitted via email, mail, or through the slot located on the front door of Town Hall and Town staff can walk you through payment via credit card, if required.

March 19 Town Council Meeting

The Town Council of Centreville will hold their regular meeting on March 19th however, due to the County and Town policy, no public access to the building will be permitted.
